Friends.

Do you ever wonder if preachers keep thinking about their sermons? I can assure you we do. Here are excerpts of what I am carrying with me from Sunday's sermon as I work to live more faithfully:

"Sometimes Jesus and his priorities make us uncomfortable. And, if we are honest, Jesus is just who we need.

"Because we live in a world where not only are our systems built on white supremacist values but where it has become more acceptable to be openly racist.

"We live in a world where the rights and protections of those who identify as anything other than straight and cisgender are being taken away.

"We live in a world where weather patterns are changing, where parts of it are literally on fire because of the habits of humanity, and yet against all evidence voices of power are claiming that climate change isn't happening.

"We live in a world where immigrants and refugees are scared to go to work or to the grocery, where our schools are counseling parents to update information in case their child goes home to an empty house.

"We live in a world where people are being forgotten because profits have been deemed more important, where the wealth of a few is allowed to destroy the lives of many.

"But we are followers of Jesus. So, our mission is the same as his. How are we bringing good news to the poor and release to the captives? How are we bringing recovery of sight to the blind? How are we setting free those who are oppressed? How will we proclaim the year of the Lord's favor? How will we live as those who truly follow Jesus?"

FCC serves at Iowa City Free Lunch on Saturday, February 22. Our menu includes cheesy potatoes with ham casserole, mixed vegetables, fruit salad, green salad, bread & butter, dessert (cupcakes, cookies, bars, granola bars), juice or milk, and coffee. We expect to serve 140 meals. For the meal, you are invited to provide food items or to volunteer to serve.

The casserole signup sheet and pans with the recipe will be on the table by the church office by Sunday, February 2. To donate other food items or work on free lunch day, use the Signup Genius link above.

At any time, non-perishable items may be placed in the Free Lunch Box just inside the front doors of the church, and casseroles and desserts may be placed in the FCC kitchen freezer. Items may also be delivered to church on Friday, February 21 between 11:30 am -1:00 pm. All meal items must be at the church by 1 pm, February 21 at which time they will be transported directly to the FLP kitchen.

First Christian Church prepares and serves free lunch on the 4th Saturday every other month. Our 2025 dates are April 26, June 28, August 23, October 25 and December 27. The guests at Free Lunch truly appreciate your generosity!
