Dear Friends.

We've been talking about generosity throughout the month of September. I want to share with you some of the ways that I am witnessing generosity in you.

We just changed our structure for planning ministries at FCC and we had four people who eagerly said yes to leading our new Ministry Teams and many more of you who said you are willing to serve with those teams. Thank you for sharing your gifts and time so generously.

Starting at the beginning of September, I now teach four Bible study classes each week (3 sections of Discovering the Bible and our longstanding Wednesday study). Every time I sit down at the table with you all, I am overwhelmed by the generosity of your minds and spirits. We are often introducing new concepts and looking at things in different ways and you are attending with curiosity.

Sunday a family worshiped with us. They are going through a hard time. We have been praying for their daughter who is in the children's hospital. But you aren't just praying. When you met them, you surrounded them with your love and compassion, with offers of meals and coffee and a place to do laundry. You were so generous with them.

We have had several folks join First Christian on recent Sundays. While I haven't asked this exact question, I think many of them have been drawn to FCC because of the ways you are generous with each other and with our community.

While we don't always name it exactly this way, generosity is a large part of our faith. It shapes how we interact with those who are different from us, how we honor the young and the vulnerable among us, how we take responsibility within our communities, how we offer what we have for the good of the whole. Thank you for all the ways you show generosity!

WARM WINTER WEAR DISTRIBUTION ABAI


THRU OCTOBER 12
