# Capital Campaign Modates

**Financial Update:** We have now passed the one-year mark since Commitment Sunday for our "A Place for Everyone" Capital Campaign. We had \$265,080 pledged (that is more than our goal!) and to date \$200,754 (\$183,829 from those who pledged) has been donated. What great progress! If you made a pledge, be watching your email inbox or USPS mailbox for an update on your progress toward your pledge.

Help Needed: We will be getting the sanctuary ready for our new chairs. Part of the getting ready is going to be removing the pews we now have, which will require the help of as many hands as willing and are able. We will be taking the pews apart so that we can dispose of them in a ecological and economical way. Anyone helping will need to be able to lift and use light tools such as power saw, drills, and screw drivers. We will be doing a test on a pew this week so that we can figure out the best way to dismantle them.

- The plan is to start <u>after church on June 9</u>, and we will take apart as many as we can that afternoon.
- We will have a construction roll-off beginning on the 10th so we will work on dismantling and removing the pews as needed, all week.

Please contact Jim Michel or John McKinstry to let them know you are willing to help and/or if you have power tools. After removing pews, we will have the floor cleaned before the new chairs arrive in July.

**Exciting Progress:** Yesterday the work got started. Yes, our audio/visual systems in the sanctuary and fellowship hall are being replaced. We have been waiting for this for so long and will look forward to hearing and seeing the difference it makes. Thank you ahead of time for your patience with our sound technicians who will be learning how to run new equipment.

# Sappatical Modates

We have been talking about Pastor Jill's upcoming sabbatical for months. Some of you may be wondering if it is ever going to happen. Now that summer is upon us, it is getting closer. As a reminder, she will be on sabbatical from August 1 - October 31.

We have shared information about what our church staff will be doing and who will be added to the church staff. But churches aren't reliant on staff alone. Rather each person in a congregation is gifted to share in ministry.

The sabbatical has given us a good opportunity to ask questions, not only about who will do things in Jill's absence, but about what roles should be shared even beyond the sabbatical. Especially since COVID a lot of responsibilities that lay people used to do have been done by our staff. While we are grateful for them, we also are a people who believe in shared ministry and the "priesthood of all believers."
